

Brighter Futures Dinner Club Campaign.

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the Brighter Futures Dinner Club?

It is a year-long fundraising campaign where Jersey residents host meals of any size and ask their guests to make a contribution to support Brighter Futures.

How do I take part?

Simply choose a date, host a meal in any setting you like, and ask your guests to donate using the Brighter Futures PayPal link. Once you have held your event, you will be entered into the monthly prize draw.

Do I need to register in advance?

We encourage hosts to register through our online form so we can send you a Dinner Club pack and keep you updated throughout the campaign.

What is included in the Dinner Club host pack?

You will receive party hats, orange napkins, name cards, and information about Brighter Futures to support conversation at your event.

What kind of meal can I host?

Anything you like. A dinner party at home, a picnic, a lunch at work or in a park, a restaurant meal, or a simple gathering with family or friends. There are no restrictions on size or style.

How much should guests donate?

Hosts can suggest any amount. Guests make their contribution directly through the Brighter Futures PayPal link. All funds go towards supporting parents, carers, and children in Jersey.

Can I donate a different way?

We suggest your contribution directly through the Brighter Futures PayPal link however should you wish we are able to provide our bank details to arrange a BACS transfer.

How do the monthly prize draws work?

If you hold a Dinner Club event within a given month, you will automatically be entered into that month's draw for a dinner for four at a Jersey venue. Each month features a different venue.

What is the December grand draw?

Everyone who hosts a Dinner Club event at any point in 2026 will be entered into a thirteenth, year-end draw for a special dinner for four people. The prize will be announced later in the year.

Can businesses take part?

Yes. Workplaces can host events, match fund employee contributions, promote the campaign to staff, or support by offering a monthly or year-end prize.

Can restaurants take part?

Yes. Restaurants can host Dinner Club gatherings, promote the campaign in their venue, or donate a dinner for four as one of the monthly prizes.

Do I need to submit proof that I held an event?

No formal proof is required. We simply ask hosts to register their event, make sure donations are made through the link, and, if possible, share a photo or brief update.

Will my event be featured on social media?

If you share photos and tag Brighter Futures, we may feature your gathering to celebrate community participation across the island.

Can I host more than one Dinner Club event?

Yes. Each event counts as a separate entry into the draw for the month in which it takes place.

Where does the money go?

All donations support Brighter Futures' services for parents, carers, and children in Jersey, including practical support, education programmes, and wellbeing services.
